These concerns may be for anything we want to rid ourselves and the world of... including the apparent divisiveness in our country, our community and even in our homes... including all forms of racism, sexism, homophobia, xenophobia (fear of the other) and all forms of fear in all of its hideous disguises.

### LISTENING SESSIONS
