woman at the well

searching and praying and pleading for an answer longing for months and years all along, it was there in the flow of the Scriptures waiting for me all the time, in the familiarity of Living Water drawn up by "the woman at the well" (John 4:4) this water that quenches spiritual thirst—ended the draught separating me from the *Inclusive Jesus*

I am the woman at the well— we <u>all</u> are divided, unware, confused, longing

yet, in the patience of the process, Jesus invites, **includes**, loves

Jesus, knowing it was against all customs and traditions, took the risk and asked her for a drink shocked that a Jew would ask a Samaritan woman for anything, much less talk to her at all, His request for a drink to soothe His thirst became an offer to her for Him to quench her thirst with eternal Living Water—and she pleaded for a drink

in this reading, I found that we don't have to prove worthiness in fact, the less we try to prove it, the worthier we feel we need to take the leap from cliff to cliff to be our unique and wonderful selves as if we had the confidence of a cougar and the insight of a fire fly Divine spark deep within lights the path we are to take to further our journey and bond fully with the God of the universe

it is God who brought us here, on this unique adventure, and God who will bring us back to full communion through the voice of the *Spirit*led—in my life—by the person of Jesus Christ

it is this personal relationship, in universal Presence, that shepherds me on my path, with the help of numerous other teachers and persuaders

so, the Triune God gives me the fourth dimension of "Grace and Love" to fulfill the power of my presence, and an invitation back to the Source when my well runs dry
