FROM THE CENTRAL CITY PARISHES TOWN HALL MEETING

FROM YOUR NEWLY NAMED PASTOR

This letter was read by Fr. Tim Kitzke to the Central City Parishes at the Town Hall Meeting that was held at the Cathedral on Monday, April 22.

April 22, 2024

My dear brothers and sisters of St. Rose of Lima, St. Michael, St. Martin de Porres and All Saints Parishes:

Greetings and blessings to you from Bogota, Colombia. It is with nervous excitement that I look forward to serving as your parochial administrator beginning mid-June. Excitement because I know I will learn much from your experiences of faith; and nervous for the same reason – there is so much to learn!

Indeed, as I have prayed over my assignment from Archbishop Listecki (whose trust humbles me), I am filled with joy at the opportunity to directly experience your long witness to the faith in the heart of the city of Milwaukee – oftentimes on the frontlines of historic moments. For a long time, I have also admired how your parishes have striven to be signs of social justice in settings of profound social injustice. Likewise, I have been moved by how members from many places and cultures come to the same worship space to share the same faith.

This collective witness of dedicated faith in the four parishes and in the neighborhoods that compromise them, seems to me to be a unique and powerful opportunity to live out what it is to be Church: an assembly, a community of believers called out to come together and be united in the same heart ("One"); to reflect God's love in Creation ("Holy"); from many parts and cultures ("Catholic"); founded on the Apostles and, like them, sent out ("Apostolic"). What a beautiful and awesome opportunity!

And I sincerely give thanks to God that I get to be a part of this opportunity, with the solid foundation of the good work already done. From this base, I pray that we can grow together as a multicultural community to be not so much the mundane "Milwaukee Central City parishes," but rather to be the Missionary Heart of the city and of the Archdiocese as a whole.

As such, I am humbled, and excited, to be part of something so great as being part of the Missionary Heart of Milwaukee together with you. Again, I have so much to learn from all of you, and I am thankful for the opportunity to do so.

Please pray for me, as I pray for you.

TOWNHALL MEETING SUMMARY LETTER

April 29, 2024

Dear Friends of Saint Michael, Saint Rose, Saint Martin de Porres, and All Saints Parishes:

On Monday, April 22, 2024, I had the opportunity and honor of joining leaders and members of your faith communities for a Townhall Meeting at the Cathedral of Saint John the Evangelist in Milwaukee. This letter is a summary of that meeting, the goals of which were for us to meet each other, discuss the upcoming pastoral transition, and look toward the future.

FIRST, HOW DID WE GET HERE?

One year ago, Father Mike Erwin was assigned as Pastor of your four parishes, along with three Associate Pastors: Father Anthony Okore, Father Onildo Orellana FMM, and Father Chakrit Micaphitak. The decision to link the four parishes together was born of the reality that your parishes are no longer able to remain financially independent of each other. Also a year ago, an Archdiocesan team was created to assist with supporting and administering the four parishes. Many of those Archdiocesan leaders attended the April 22nd townhall meeting. The work of this team included supporting your parishes in areas of finance, human resources, buildings and facilities, communications, and ministry. The team made great progress in the summer and fall! Then in late Fall of 2023, Father Mike began to communicate some health concerns to us, which grew to the point of necessitating his current health leave, along with his decision to discontinue his role as pastor of your parishes in order to continue to improve his health. The Archbishop and I understand and support his decision.

WHERE ARE WE NOW?

With Father Mike on health leave, the Archbishop appointed Father Tim Kitzke as your Interim Administrator. Many of you know Father Tim for his longstanding commitment to your parishes and to the city as Vicar of Urban Ministry. Father Kitzke was also present at the April 22nd townhall meeting to share his continued faith, love, and support of you and your parishes. I am grateful for his ministry. Additionally, Shanedra Johnson has agreed to serve as your Interim Ministry Coordinator during this same timeframe. Her love and care for these parish communities is evident in all she does,

and I am grateful for her continued bridge-building as we navigate this pastoral transition together. Additionally, the Archdiocesan team continues to support your overall operations and ministries.

WHERE ARE WE GOING?

Father Mike Erwin will briefly return from his health leave in late May, and your new Parochial Administrator (Pastor) Father Mike Wolfe will arrive in late June. Father Mike Wolfe has written a heartfelt letter to you, which is also included in this bulletin; please take time to read it. Father Tim and I have been in regular contact with him and he is so excited to be with you! In the meantime, and as we plan for the future, these four parishes need to stay together. You are stronger together than apart. The Archdiocese is committed to supporting your new Pastor, and we will continue to work with you on viable administration, facilities, finances, and ministry needs. The four parishes will need to think about their position and resource needs as much as possible as one family – as a group in a common household with one Father.

I appreciate the honesty surrounding the concerns that were raised by the parish members at the April 22nd meeting, including (but not limited to): difficult recent history, historical frustrations over leadership and with the Archdiocese, past wounds still un-healed, the need for respect and understanding, concerns about financial support, the need for cultural competence and sensitivity in any new pastor, the importance of outreach, planning, inclusion, and collaboration. It is my sincere hope and prayer that our shared faith will guide us forward to address these concerns and help us to accomplish this purpose: To strategize and implement viable and sustainable Catholic parishes to serve the diversity of Milwaukee's Central City, focused on vibrancy in worship, service, and teaching.

Please know of my, and Archbishop Listecki's, renewed commitment to our Central City, and our promise to continue to walk with you through this pastoral transition and the challenges ahead. I thank your trustees, parish staff, Archdiocesan staff, and Father Tim for their continued support and commitment.

Lillie Holloman has been asked to continue one more year.


ALL SAINTS PARISH
