FROM THE DESK OF OUR PAROCHIAL ADMINISTRATOR

March 2025

Dear friends in Christ,

What we today call “Lent” was originally only the time of preparation of those who would be baptized in the early Church. We still see this today in what we call the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (“OCIA”). In the parishes where we have candidates, we will live out several different rites in preparation of these adults receiving the sacraments of baptism, communion, and confirmation during the Easter Vigil.

Overtime in the ancient Church, the practice of dedicating 40 days before Easter as a special time of preparation was seen as valuable for all the faithful, and eventually became a formal part of the liturgical year. Thus, Lent is connected to our baptism. And it is through our baptism that, as Pope Francis reminds us often, we become missionary disciples. We are disciples in that we follow Jesus, and missionaries in that we are sent out by him to share with others what we have received (cf 1 Cor 11:23).

This year, our Lenten theme for the Central MKE Catholic Communities is “Embrace the Journey.” Sometimes we can see Lent as something negative in that we are asked to deprive ourselves from things we like to do, or to be more generous than we naturally would like to be. But I have come to see it as a very profound time of year in which I readjust and renew to better live out being a missionary disciple, to be a better Christian. It’s analogous to going to a training camp for some sport: it can be hard work, it can be intense and sometimes not fun, but then we perform better in the race, so to speak (cf. 2 Tim 4:7). It also leads us to better appreciate what Jesus does for us, and who we are for God.

Ultimately, if we do not prepare fully for Holy Week, we will not fully renewed come Easter, and miss the opportunity to live out more fully our baptism. But if we are intentional in this time of preparation, we can strengthen in our faith and knowing that we can do all things in Christ, because of what he has done for us (cf. Phil 4:13). The ways that we are invited to live out Lent is through the three pillars of prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

So let us confidently “Embrace the Journey” this Lent. We have many opportunities for prayer as well as for confession. We have many outreach programs that can use your support and dedicated service hours. Regarding fasting, remember those of us who are 14 and over are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday; and from ages 18 to 59 are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday (meaning one meal, and two smaller meals). Those who wish can of course do more.

By intentionally embracing the journey of this Lent, we will come out the other side more dedicated and stronger in our faith journey together.

Matthew 25: 36... in Prison and you visited me.

This year, our Lenten Almsgiving will focus on prison ministry, families of the incarcerated, and re-entry programs locally and worldwide.

In this Jubilee Year 2025, "Pilgrims in Hope," Pope Francis has designated a set of Holy Doors at Rome's Rebibbia Prison. Pope Francis invites us to contemplate the belief of a Holy Door, a "Door of Mercy," in which anyone who enters will experience the love of God who consoles, pardons, and instills hope.

Judge Mary E. Triggiano is the Director of the Andrew Center for Restorative Justice and a Clinical Professor of Law at Marquette University Law School. She teaches Restorative Justice and the Restorative Justice Clinic and is the former Chief Judge for Milwaukee County Circuit Court.

"Vengeance or Justice"

Biography:

Via a life sentence handed down three days after his 15th birthday for a gang-related homicide, Adam Procell spent nearly a quarter-century behind bars. During his incarceration, he renounced his gang affiliation and published 'Anatomizing the Gang Culture.' Adam is a founding partner at Paradigm Shyft, a strategic reentry consulting firm, and is working to unify Milwaukee's reentry services through a shared reentry resource model called "Home To Stay." Additionally, he wrote Act 233, a law requiring the state to establish a community reentry center, and serves as an adjunct instructor at Marquette University. He is also a TEDx speaker, highlighting his work within the trenches of change.

Carol Kent is a bestselling author and an international speaker for conventions, retreats, conferences, and fundraising events. She's the executive director of Speak Up, Inc., which includes the Speak Up Conference, an event committed to helping people develop their speaking and writing skills, and Speak Up MasterMind and Intensive Coaching Groups for speakers, writers, and leaders.

Carol and her husband, Gene, founded the nonprofit organization Speak Up for Hope, which benefits inmates and their families. Carol holds a master's degree in communication arts and a bachelor's degree in speech education. She has trained speakers for over twenty-five years and has been featured at Women of Faith, Extraordinary Women, and Women of Joy arena events. She is the author of over twenty-seven books, including the bestselling *When I Lay My Isaac Down*, *Speak Up with Confidence*, and *He Holds My Hand*.
