FROM THE DESK OF OUR PAROCHIAL ADMINISTRATOR

April 2025

Dear Friends:

My goodness do we have a lot going on in our parishes! And we haven't even gotten to Holy Week yet!

I would especially like to give a shout out to all those involved to

make the Mass of Welcome with Archbishop Grob a success on March 30. It was, in the words of the Archbishop himself, "a tremendous celebration." The liturgy was spectacular, especially with the mixed choir from all four parishes. The reception afterward was bountiful and delicious. And it was a fulfillment of my prayer that the celebration be a sign to the new Archbishop and to all of our unity in our diversity, and that yes, the faith is very much alive in central Milwaukee!

Taking advantage of the archbishop being with us and there being representation from all four parishes, I decided to request that I be installed during the mass. Now, some of you may say, "but weren't you already pastor?" Technically, no. I was "parochial administrator," which is basically has the same responsibilities, but for a temporary period. Not much changes honestly, other that I am now officially pastor and the presumption is that I will be in this role for a good long while (the letter says six years). I give thanks to God and to Archbishop Grob, because I have truly felt at home with all of you and privileged to serve such beautiful and diverse parishes. I am blessed to have been so well received despite my many limitations. Thank you! (By the way, the priest that made me want to be a priest was there, Fr. Leonard Barbian, which meant a lot to me - and thank you all involved for making me look good!).

The ceremony for the installation of a pastor is simple but powerful. The Archbishop introduces the priest to the community, and then introduces leaders of the community (in our case, communities) to the priest. The to-be pastor then must make an oath of fidelity to the Church, its Sacred Tradition, and Sacred Scripture, while placing his hand of the book of the Gospel. I assure you that one does not do this lightly!

At the end of my installation, Archbishop Grob prayed: "Strengthen our brother MICHAEL DAVID as he begins a new ministry among us, and help us all to follow your Son Jesus Christ, who is Lord, for ever and ever."

As we come to the end of the Lenten season, having embraced the journey in the desert, may we enter Holy Week praying for one another. Let us pray all of the families at St. Rose of Lima, St. Martin de Porres, St. Michael and All Saints that make up our united faith-family so that upon celebrating the most Holy Triduum, we are able to refocus ourselves on what is most important. It is not the buildings, not the different groups, not all the things that can preoccupy and distract us. Rather it is that we more faithfully follow Jesus, together. With this, the rest will fall in place.


