FROM OUR PASTOR'S DESK

June 2026

Introducing the Central City Catholic Parish Foundation

Dear Friends,

In all four of our parishes we spend a lot of time addressing immediate needs. Many of our buildings need repairs, boilers and windows need to be replaced, and do not forget some of those roof leaks! We have amazing outreach programs that need funding to keep them going. And our electricity bills can reach thousands of dollars each month. Thanks be to God, we are trending in a very good direction with this regard, but we must at the same time be looking to the future.

Just past generations have done for us, it is our responsibility to ensure that there is a dedicated Catholic parish presence in the Central City into the future. This is especially important now because as a collective All Saints, St. Martin de Porres, St. Michael and St. Rose of Lima serve a large area of the city and include the most economically distressed zip codes. When I was assigned to serve in the Central City, I was told that the Central City was “mission territory,” and indeed, that has been my experience during my almost two years as administrator and pastor.

The soil is ready for planting the seeds of the Gospel - and we must be present as a Church to do so. Our social outreach programs, prayer life and beautiful spaces bring light and hope. Our presence allows other parishes in the Archdiocese to partner in outreach to those in need. Our collaboration forms the “missionary heart” of the Archdiocese. Our presence is important not only for us who attend Mass on Sundays, but for the good of the greater Mission.

It is for this reason that I, together with the trustees of all four parishes, requested that Archbishop Grob erect the Central City Catholic Parish Foundation. This is a tool that allows for fundraising in the name of the collaboration of all four parishes. Most importantly, it is through this foundation that we have established a “fund for the future,” like an endowment, from which 5% of investments will be distributed to be used each year as decided by the Board. The Board of our foundation is made up of the trustees of all four parishes and the pastor, all ex-officio positions.

On May 20 we had an inaugural fundraising dinner to build up our fund for the future, supported by the trustees and planned by a small ad hoc committee. I considered it a great success as we are on our way to having raised about \$300,000. If my math is right, that means that for the foreseeable future, we can count on \$15,000 each year from the fund to support our parishes! We cannot see this as an extra, however. It is rather a relief with regards to our very tight, minimal budgets.

I share this information with you as an exercise in transparency. In terms of your giving, it is important that our parishioners focus on supporting their individual parishes, at which we really need regular giving to go up. Going forward, it is my hope is that each parish have its own specific fundraiser every year where parishioners dedicate time and treasure to supporting each parish.

With regards to the Central City Catholic Parish Foundation, I only ask that you prayerfully consider remembering it in your will or trust, to leave a lasting legacy in support of the Catholic presence in the Central City. Please encourage those you know to do so as well. Some of us may not be used to speaking directly about such things, but it is only in doing so that we, and others, will become aware of this need and opportunity to make a difference. NOTA DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

junio 2026

Presentación de la Fundación de las Parroquias Católicas de Central City

Queridos amigos y amigas en Cristo:

En nuestras cuatro parroquias dedicamos gran parte de nuestro tiempo a atender necesidades inmediatas. Muchos de nuestros edificios requieren reparaciones; es necesario reemplazar calderas y ventanas, ¡sin olvidar las goteras en algunos tejados! Contamos con programas de asistencia social extraordinarios que necesitan financiación para continuar operando, y nuestras facturas de electricidad pueden ascender a miles de dólares mensuales. Gracias a Dios, hemos avanzado en la dirección correcta en este aspecto, pero al mismo tiempo debemos mirar hacia el futuro.

Al igual que hicieron las generaciones anteriores para nosotros, es nuestra responsabilidad garantizar una presencia parroquial católica sólida en Central City de cara al futuro. Esto cobra especial importancia hoy en día, ya que el conjunto de las parroquias de Todos los Santos, San Martín de Porres, San Miguel y Santa Rose de Lima presta servicio a una amplia zona de la ciudad, incluidas las áreas con mayores dificultades económicas. Cuando fui asignado a Central City, se me dijo que era un "territorio de misión", y esa ha sido, efectivamente, mi experiencia durante mis casi dos años como administrador y párroco.

Acá en la ciudad la tierra está lista para sembrar las semillas del Evangelio, y debemos estar presentes como Iglesia para hacerlo. Nuestros programas de asistencia social, nuestra vida de oración y nuestros hermosos espacios llevan luz y esperanza. Nuestra presencia permite que otras parroquias de la Arquidiócesis colaboren en la ayuda a los necesitados. Nuestra colaboración constituye el "corazón misionero" de la Arquidiócesis. Nuestra presencia es importante no solo para quienes asistimos a Misa los domingos, sino para el bien de la Misión en su conjunto.

Por este motivo, junto con los miembros de las juntas directivas de las cuatro parroquias (los "trustees"), solicitamos al Arzobispo Grob la creación de la Fundación de las Parroquias Católicas de Central City. Esta fundación es una herramienta que permite recaudar fondos en nombre de la colaboración entre las cuatro parroquias. Lo más importante es que, a través de ella, hemos establecido un "fondo para el futuro" —similar a un fondo de dotación—, del cual se distribuirá anualmente el 5 % de las inversiones para los fines que determine la Junta Directiva. Dicha Junta está integrada por los "trustees" de las cuatro parroquias y por el párroco, todos ellos en virtud de sus cargos.

El 20 de mayo celebramos una cena inaugural de recaudación de fondos para fortalecer nuestro fondo de reserva para el futuro; el evento contó con el apoyo de la junta directiva y fue organizado por un pequeño comité ad hoc. Considero que fue un gran éxito, ya que estamos en camino de recaudar cerca de 300.000 dólares. Si mis cálculos son correctos, ¡esto significa que, en el futuro previsible, podremos contar con 15.000 dólares anuales provenientes de dicho fondo para apoyar a nuestras parroquias! Sin embargo, no debemos ver esto como un ingreso extra, sino más bien como un alivio para nuestros presupuestos, que son sumamente ajustados y mínimos.

Comparto esta información con ustedes como un ejercicio de transparencia. En cuanto a sus donaciones, es importante que los feligreses se centren en apoyar a sus propias parroquias, donde realmente necesitamos aumentar las contribuciones regulares. De cara al futuro, espero que cada parroquia organice su propia campaña anual de recaudación de fondos, en la que los feligreses dediquen tiempo y recursos económicos para apoyar a su comunidad parroquial.

Respecto a la "Central City Catholic Parish Foundation" (Fundación de Parroquias Católicas del Centro de la Ciudad), les pido que consideren en oración la posibilidad de incluirla en su testamento o fideicomiso, dejando así un legado duradero que respalde la presencia católica en el centro de la ciudad. Por favor, animen también a sus conocidos a hacer lo mismo. Quizás algunos no estemos acostumbrados a hablar abiertamente de estos temas, pero solo al hacerlo tomaremos conciencia —nosotros y los demás— de esta necesidad y de la oportunidad de marcar una diferencia. Y, por supuesto, les pido que sigan rezando por nuestros esfuerzos conjuntos para fortalecer el corazón misionero de la ciudad.

Fr. Mike and parish staff will **NEVER** request gift cards via e-mail, text, or phone.

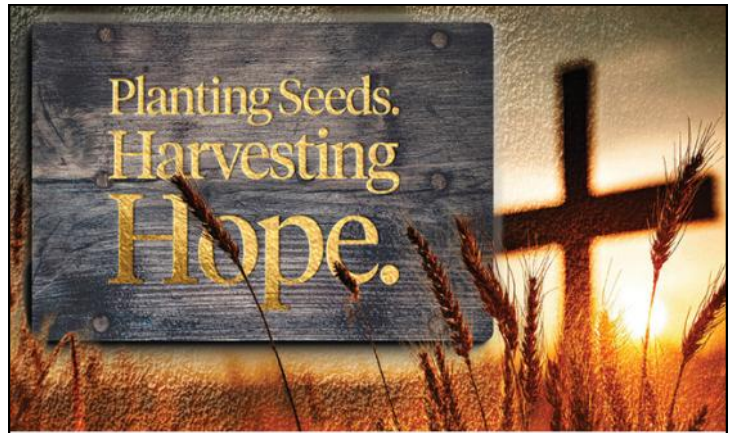
WATCH FOR THESE RED FLAGS:

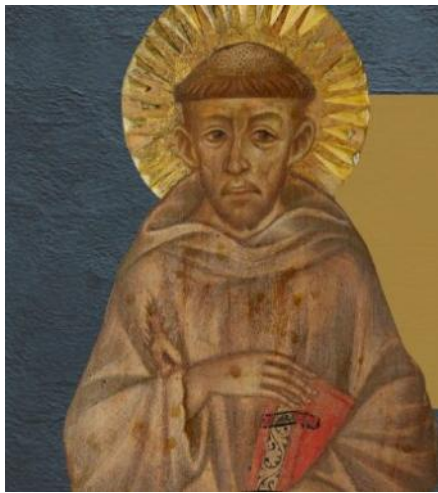

Jubilee Year of St. Francis

Jan 10, 2026 to Jan 10, 2027

Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed an extraordinary Jubilee Year in honor of the 800th anniversary of the death of St. Francis of Assisi, to be observed from January 10, 2026, through January 10, 2027. During this special year of grace, the faithful are invited to deepen their conversion, embrace the spirit of peace and humility that marked the life of Francis, and renew their witness to the Gospel in the world today.

WHAT IS A JUBILEE YEAR?

A Jubilee is a special time of grace proclaimed by the Church, calling the faithful to spiritual renewal, reconciliation and deeper union with God. This extraordinary Jubilee commemorates eight centuries of Franciscan witness — a legacy that continues to shape the Church's mission of charity, care for creation and solidarity with the poor. As an extension of the Ordinary Jubilee of 2025, it offers the entire Church a renewed occasion for encounter with God's mercy.
